Before me, the undersigned Assistant District Attorney of Harris County, Texas, this day appeared the undersigned affiant, who under oath says that he has good reason to believe and does believe that in Harris County, Texas, **LAKESHA WOODS WILLIAMS**, hereafter styled the Defendant, heretofore on or about **April 4, 2024 through April 9, 2024**, did then and there unlawfully, having care, custody, and control of **K O**, a child younger than fifteen years of age and hereafter called the Complainant, intentionally abandon the Complainant at 9757 Katy Fwy, Houston, TX, 77024, Unit #2112, under circumstances that exposed the Complainant to an unreasonable risk of harm, namely by leaving home for four days with luggage, leaving an 8 year old and a 6 year old alone in an apartment without adult supervision or care and with the intent to return for the Complainant, and the Defendant did not voluntarily deliver the Complainant to a designated emergency infant care provider under Section 262 302, Texas Family Code

**Probable Cause**

Your Affiant, J Andrade, a peace officer employed by the Harris County Constable's Office, Pct 5, believes and has reason to believe that the defendant, Lakesha Woods Williams (DOB 03/26/1995), committed the offense Endanger a Child, on or about, April 4, 2024 through April 9, 2024 in Harris County, Texas

**YOUR AFFIANT BASES THIS BELIEF UPON THE FOLLOWING FACTS**

On April 9, 2024, I Deputy J Andrade (5E21) was dispatched at approximately 10 58AM to a call for service regarding a Wellness Check located at 9757 Katy Fwy Houston, Tx 77024 (The Mckinley Apartments #2112) in Harris County, Texas Deputies arrived on scene and found Zelina Hazer, hereafter the Witness The Witness stated that she was made aware by other residents in the apartment complex that two juveniles had been left alone inside of Unit #2112, and were worried about their safety

The witness stated that other residents had observed the juveniles' mother leaving with luggage and bags on approximately April 4, 2024, around noon, and never saw her return to the location Many of the residents were worried of the children and have said this is not the first time that something like this had occurred The Witness was able to give us the mother's information using the apartment records, and identified her as Lakesha Williams, D O B 03/26/1995, FLID# W324-520-95-606-0, hereinafter referred to as the Defendant

Deputies arrived and made contact with the two juveniles, one 8 year old male **K O**, and one 6 year old female **K O** Deputies cleared the apartment and made sure no one else was inside the unit with the juveniles

The apartment was in complete disarray and had trash and left-over food all over the unit The unit also had a very potent smell of urine and both juveniles stated that their mother (Defendant) had left them since April 4, 2024, to go on vacation on a cruise and they did not know when she would return No adults were present supervising the juveniles, and none appeared to have been present since the Defendant's departure

Upon further investigation, deputies found a camera the Defendant was using to watch and talk to the children while she was away One of the juveniles, the 8 year old son **K O**, also had a phone he was using to text with the Defendant while she was gone The phone was taken by deputies and tagged as evidence at 17423 Katy Fwy Houston Tx 77094 (TL6 Locker) HFD was called to the scene to make sure both juveniles were in good health and not malnourished CPS was contacted by deputies REF#78735220 (Erica 5594) CPS agent Amyiah Burton also made the scene and spoke to both juveniles and their aunt, who arrived to take custody of the juveniles Both Juveniles were

released to their aunt Gwendolyn Graham Williams


Deputies tried contacting the Defendant to make the scene, but she was not cooperating and was switching up her story on her whereabouts




