1:36 PM Defendant Anissa E Weier in court with attorneys Joseph Smith and Maura McMahon. Attorneys Ted Szczupakiewicz and Kevin Osborne appeared for the State of Wisconsin.

The Court addresses the conditional release plan. Both parties have reviewed the conditional release plan. The Court notes that the author of the report Ms. Slawson is in court today. No questions at this time by either party to Ms. Slawson.

The Court will release the conditional release plan after the hearing is complete.

Attorney McMahon requests that Ms. Weier's address be redacted from the plan. The Court orders that Ms. Weier's address be redacted, so ordered.

Attorney Szczupakiewicz requests to modify the plan to include language as to the GPS monitoring language. Attorney McMahon makes statements as to that being left up to the case manager.

Statements by Attorney Jennifer Dunn. Questions by the Court as to anything Attorney Dunn might want to include in the report. Response by Attorney Dunn stating not at this time.

The Court makes statements as to if the GPS requirement is to be modified, the Court will need to be notified 30 days before. This will be included as an amendment to the plan.

Attorney McMahon states there is a request from the Department of Corrections to return Ms. Weier to Winnebago Mental Health Institution until Monday to be released from their facility.

Attorney Szczupakiewicz states there is a request to allow the evaluations done previously by the doctors for the conditional release to be released to Waukesha County providers.

Questions by the Court as to the additional two evaluations of Ms. Weier being released.

Response by Department of Corrections Agent Shannon Stydakar-Schulz requesting the release of the conditional release letters from 3/1/21 and 6/28/21. No objections by Attorney McMahon. The Court orders the release of these documents as well as the evaluations from Dr. Rawski, Dr. Collins, and Dr. Westendorf, to be included in the order.

Questions by the Court as to any objections to the modifications of the report. Response by Attorney McMahon stating no objections.

The Court finds that the report is fair and reasonable and provides protection for both the community and Ms. Weier.

The Court approves the conditional release plan and authorizes the release of the report.

The Court orders Ms. Weier's address be sealed/redacted, so ordered.

The Court approves the request for the modification of the GPS language and orders the Court be notified 30 days before.

The Court directs Ms. Weier to be returned to Winnebago Mental Health Institution until Monday at which time to be released from their facility.

Conditional release plan to be filed with the Court by September 1, 2021. Defendant is ok with the next court date exceeding the 60 days for the review hearing.

Defendant is remanded back to Winnebago Mental Health pending review of the conditional release plan/further order of the Court.

Court to sign order for conditional release plan.

Next Court date to be held either in Judge Bohren's or Judge Melvin's new courtroom in the tower.

Review hearing scheduled for September 10, 2021 at 09:00 am. Check Case scheduled for September 1, 2021.
