CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

The Defendant shall adhere to the following conditions once released from jail on bond.

1. Appear to answer and to submit to all orders and process of the Court.
2. Refrain from committing any criminal offense.
3. Do not depart the State of Alabama without leave of the Court.
4. Promptly notify the clerk of the court of any change of address.
5. Do not attend or appear at any event or any public place alone and without a spouse or adult family member where any person under the age of 18 years is present.
6. Do not have contact, directly or indirectly with the victim or the victim's family.
7. Do not have any contact, directly or indirectly with any witness in this case.

The provisions of the Conditions of Release may be revoked or modified by the Court for cause. These conditions shall remain in effect until dismissal, acquittal or conviction on the charges unless sooner revoked or modified by the Court.

Upon substantiated report of any violation of any of the above conditions a warrant for your arrest will be issued.
