# Victims Statement

Kaylor Case

My name is Joe Guardipee, I'm here to state ~~to~~ what you did, how it not only affected my family, but how it affected me personally.

A long time ago, long before you were born. I went away to Southeast Asia, a place called Vietnam. While serving there with the United States Marine Corp, I saw many atrocities. People on both sides mutilated and killed. Young people severely burned beyond recognition, babies crying for there dead mothers. Fellow Marines blown w half by booby traps and incoming rounds.

When I returned back to the world, I tried to put the trauma behind me, and go on with life. It took many years and copius amounts of alcohol to push those memories to the far reaches of my mind. Over time I was able to cope with the past, and live a somewhat normal life, until June 18<sup>TH</sup> 2023. On that day, my world once again turned upside down.

This country is based on rules and laws, that's how a society functions. What you did that day was well beyond any sanity of a normal human. You decided to be judge and jury, you decided to play God. You decided to take matter in your own hand, you decided it was ok to take the lives of four of my family members. Well let me tell you about my family members.

She was a young hardworking single mother, who was doing her best to raise two boys, with no help from the father. A bit protective of her sons, but what good mother isn't. But that didn't matter to you when you executed her.

### Kenny

He finally reached retirement age, was going to enjoy some of the so called golden years. Recently had a heart attack, and was recovering from it. I doubt he was much of a threat to you when you blew him away.

### Aiken

A 16 year old innocent kid, who never hurt a soul. In fact he was a great lad, a member of the high school junior ROTC. He spent countless hours helping people. He was an asset to his valley. He planned to make the military his career, and would have been an asset to his nation. He never got the chance to fulfill his dreams, or even have a life. You took that from him when you ruthlessly and wantonly murdered him. He didn't deserve that.

### Dennis

A young boy just graduated from high school, with his future ahead of him. He had some mental issues. His family was dealing with. Being low income counselling was virtually impossible. They had applied to the state for help, but found there's money there for incarceration, but not for mental health, so they were dealing with it the best they could.

Sure he masturbated, in his own house, in his own bedroom. I'm positive you have done the very same thing yourself at some time or other in your life. But behold you decided he wasn't fit to live, so you viciously massacred and mutilated him with a large amount of lead bullets.

You said you snapped, did you snap when you told a co-worker you were going to do something that would get you in trouble later.

Did you snap when you loaded 2 magazines to the maximum with ammunition. Did you snap when you strapped on a semi automatic pistol

Did you snap when you crept around casing the apartments, looking for your victims, prior ~~to~~ the incident. Did you snap when you confronted them and continuously pulled the trigger until both magazines were empty.

You said you were protecting your children, let me ask you, who's protecting them now? All you did is traumatise them. They ~~will~~<sup>will</sup> spend the rest of their lives knowing their father is nothing more than a 2 bit killer. They may even be blaming themselves for this wicked event, let alone the peer pressure they'll have to contend with as they grow.

What a man you are, not only did you destroy my family, but yours as well.

Hello your honor, my name is Teresa. I am Kennas aunt and Devin and Aikens great aunt. Jeri is my sister.

I would like to start by saying that every person I know has suffered with grief one way or another. This your honor, this is a monster. My mind goes places I never imagined it would. Four lives were taken that day nine months ago and i can't wrap my brain around it still. This has broken our family in different ways. For my sister the loss is greater than can be understood or explained by any of us. The pain she goes through ever single day can't be described. She has lost her family. The ones she lives for. Her only child and her only grandchildren. Jeri has asked me what is she supposed to do with her life now or she will say I don't know what I'm going to do with my life because they are all gone. It is a terrible feeling knowing that what ever I say will not help her in the slightest. I wonder where she gathers the strength to even get up out of bed each day.

So much could be said about Kenna,Devin,Aiken and Kenny. Kenna a single mom that worked harder than ever to raise her babies. She was a good momma. She was tough, strong willed and very independent. She always made sure her boys had everything they needed and some things that they wanted. Kenna had a love for the outdoors and passed that on to Devin and Aiken. They all were found on the mountain skiing in the winter and mountain biking the rest of the year. Devin and Aiken were so young still. So much life ahead of them. It was all just taken away from them so tragically. Devin had just graduated from high school and was figuring out what was next. Aiken was going places and had so many dreams to catch. He could already see what his future looked like after high school and was so excited about it. He was going to make a difference in the world. Aiken had already made a difference in our community. Kenny was the grandpa that was always around to keep an eye on the kids when Kenna couldn't be with them.

I have such mixed emotions about the person who so brutally took the lives of Kenna, Devin, Aiken and Kenny. Most days anger. I want him to feel the pain Jeri does every day but without his babies actually being murdered. I think about his kiddos and how his actions will send them down a life path that they have no choice in taking. It's going to be rough for them. They won't grow up to be the adults they would have become had he not took the lives of Kenna Devin Aiken and Kenny. Four humans lives just like that. Gone

Majorjon Kaylor is a weak person. Easily influenced and because of that so many lives have forever been changed in the worst possible way.

I have faith in our justice system. There are no amount of years that can right the wrong for taking the lives of Kenna, Devin, Aiken and Kenny. I hope that he is aware that every year, month and day that you will be handing down to him for sentencing will be some justice for our family. He can't be in his children's every day life. No good night kisses or good morning hugs. No late night snuggles with his wife. He may get some visits, pictures and letters. To be honest I struggle with that. Just doesn't seem fair. Jeri gets nothing. Not ever again will she hear her daughters voice or get hugs from her boys. If what he did to our family doesn't haunt him every day I hope that at least what he did to his family does.

A good father would not leave his children to defend his actions as they grow up in this small community, knowing and living every day that their father murdered innocent human beings.

There are many other attributes to being a good father but he is none of them!

I hate the fact that my family will never be the same, that we will never get to celebrate holidays and milestones, that we will never hear their voices again, and that my sister and her husband has to live without a daughter and 2 grandsons. I hate the mood and sadness when we enter this courtroom because it reminds us of that terrible day.

I find it ironic that he took justice in his own hands because he didn't believe in the justice system. Here we sit in this court room, waiting for the fate of his life.



We believe in the justice system and believe the sentence that will be executed to him today, will not compare with how he executed our family, but will help us move towards healing from this senseless act.

Our family will never be the same but I know justice will prevail.

Kenny, Kenna, Devin and Aiken were taken from us way too soon. This murderer decided he was the judge, jury and executioner. Kenna raised her two boys on her own, without any help from their deadbeat dad. It's not right for parents to have their kids go before them and they for sure shouldn't see their grandchildren go before them. He killed an entire branch of our family tree, nothing left, no other brothers or sisters never any great grandchildren to watch grow up. We spent a lot of time with both boys as they were growing up but as teenagers, they have their own things to do but Aiken still spent a lot of time with us. I am going to spend most of my letter talking about Aiken because he is the one I spent most of my time with and I not only lost an entire family but I lost my best friend. He was a shining star, new where he was going and what he wanted to do. We not only lost a member of our family but the entire community lost a great person. He was a member of the Kellogg High ROTC program and he loved it. He spent hundreds of hours volunteering throughout the community. He volunteered at the Wallace Elks, carried the colors in Veterans Day parades, spent Memorial Day traveling to all the cemeteries in the valley with ROTC honoring the fallen with 21 gun salutes. He posted the colors at many events including the Sunshine Memorial 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary honoring the memory of so many lives that were tragically lost in the fire. He loved helping out on projects, but one in particular was our jeep. We bought a 1957 jeep years ago and it needed a lot of work. He came to me one day and said Grampa it's time for us to get the jeep done, so we got together with a friend of ours and started on the project. The jeep was to be Aiken's but now I have no one to give it to because, remember, the entire branch from our family tree was killed, no Aiken to pass it on to, no Kenna or Devin, no kids of Aiken's to give it too. Now all I have is the jeep with a painting on the back, In remembrance of Aiken "Cling On" never forgotten. That is all we have of an entire beautiful family taken by one person. There has to be consequences for his actions. He needs to spend the rest of his sorry life in prison never to see the outside of the prison walls because he could do the same to some other family. He must pay.



I am the step mom to Terie Silva for almost 47 years. Kenna Guardipee is Terie's only child. Terie is the grandmother Devin and Aiken Guardipee, her only grandchildren.

This is a tragedy that we will probably never recover from.

Major Jon Allen Kaylor made the unnecessary choice to murder four of our family members to solve a problem that could have been taken care of in so many other ways. That has nothing to do with murdering two teenage boys, their mother and Grandfather.

Kenna, a hard working mother, dedicated her life making certain her her children were well taken care of and well rounded. She took them mountain bike riding, camping, fishing, & berry picking. In the winter snow boarding, all while holding a full time job. Ken lived with them to help with the boys while Kenna worked.

Aiken, 16 yrs. old was already an asset to our community. He was always offering help to anyone.



He had ~~already~~ <sup>already</sup> started making plans for his future. Aiken was in ROTC and was going to serve our country after graduation. Mr. Kaylor took all of that away. He has changed our lives and the lives of his children. Children need their Dads to be within arms reach for hugs and support at the end of the day, that Dad is proud of them and will help them grow and make good decisions until they are adults.

I am asking the court to issue the maximum penalty to Mr. Kaylor so no other family will have to go through what we go through daily.

I will be okay with whatever your judgement is. I believe in our laws, courts, constitution and karma.

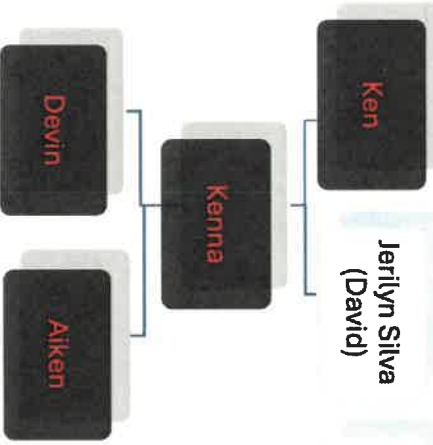
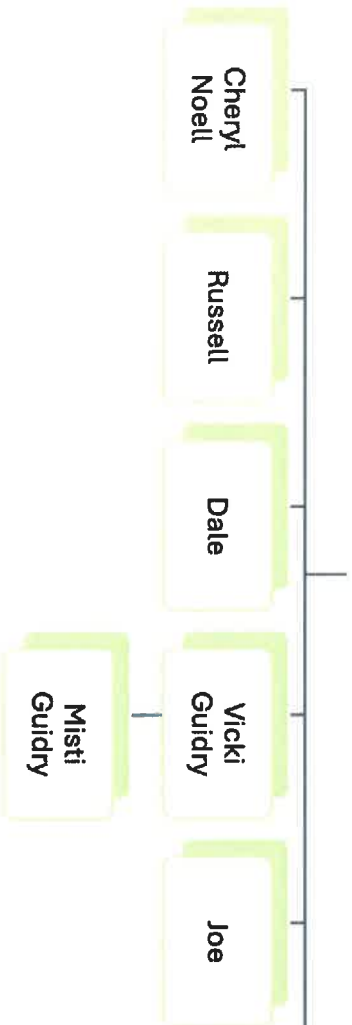
