Summary of Offenses and Probable Cause Affidavit

On 10/17/2023 at approximately 0737 hours I responded to 1661 NW St Lucie West Blvd (Walgreens) in reference to a domestic disturbance that occurred earlier this morning at 5810 NW Rose Petal Ct.

Upon my arrival I made contact with Jamie Felix (DOB: 07/14/1978) who was visibly upset and crying. Jamie stated that she was in the bathroom this morning getting ready for work and only dressed in her robe. Her husband, Ray Felix (DOB: 11/27/1963), came in the bathroom and snatched her phone out of her pocket. Jamie then advised that Ray attempts to grab her keys out of her robe pocket and Jamie didn't let him take the keys which caused Ray to grab her wrists and force her to the ground where Jamie ended up. Jamie states that they are having relational issues, and they are about to have a divorce. Jamie says Ray works at [REDACTED] and is currently there now. Jamie wants her phone back and states that Ray is very manipulative and is retired from law enforcement, so he knows how to play the police. Jamie also says that [REDACTED], was also in the bedroom and observed the entire incident. [REDACTED]

Jamie has visible marks on both of her wrists but refused rescue while on scene. UCI Officer Morales #1152 was on scene and took photographs of the marks which appeared fresh and were slightly raised and red. See Officer Morales supplement report.

I contacted SRD Deputy Lopez #SO364 who is currently assigned to [REDACTED] and made her aware of the situation. I asked Deputy Lopez if she could have [REDACTED] removed from class so that I could interview him which she agreed.

I arrived at [REDACTED] and made contact with Deputy Lopez who had [REDACTED] inside of the principal's office already. I spoke to [REDACTED] and he appeared concerned and upset and began to cry. [REDACTED] states that this morning was not a normal morning because [REDACTED] had an argument. [REDACTED] states that [REDACTED] was in the bathroom getting ready and [REDACTED] came in and grabbed her phone. [REDACTED] states that while [REDACTED] was grabbing the phone, he seen [REDACTED] slowly fall to the

ground with [REDACTED] on top of her. Afterwards, they separated and argued for several minutes afterwards. Due to [REDACTED] being so upset a counselor was requested to speak with [REDACTED] while we went and met with Ray.

On the other side of campus, we met with Ray who stated the following:

Ray states that he has been arguing with his wife, Jamie for a while regarding financial debt. Ray says Jamie has accumulated approximately \$40,000.00 worth of debt and it's not ok. This morning, Ray walked into the bathroom and seen Jamie's cellphone sticking out of her pocket, so he grabbed it because he wanted to see proof and details regarding the debt. Ray snatched the phone out of the pocket and Jamie was surprised. Ray says that's when Jamie covered her pocket up because he believes she thought Ray was going to take Jamie's keys as well but didn't. Ray denies ever putting hands on Jamie and claims she dropped to the floor herself, being over dramatic.

A domestic packet was completed with Jamie and submitted with this report.

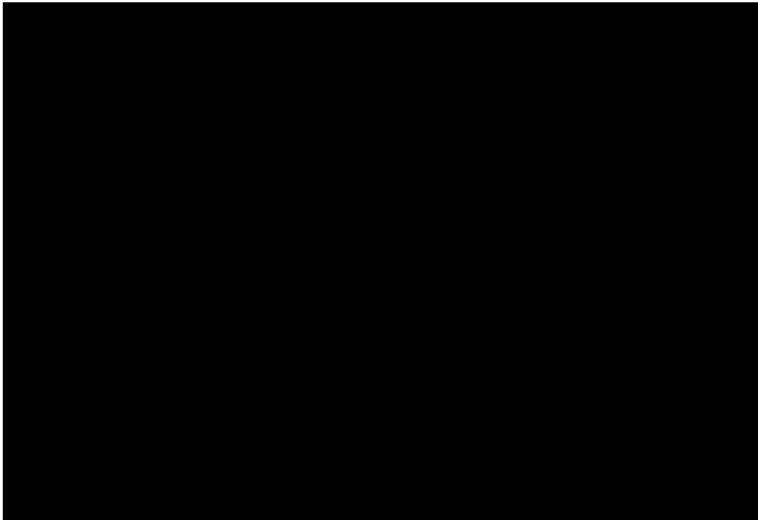
All parties were run through FCIC/NCIC and were clear.

Due to Jamie, and [REDACTED] statements, coupled with physical injuries on Jamie, I arrested Ray for Battery (Domestic) since he actually and physically touched Jamie against her will, F.S.S. 784.03.

BWC was active and uploaded to evidence.com.

Jamie's phone was recovered out of Ray's vehicle with his permission and turned over to school administrators for her to pick it up.

Ray was transported to St Lucie County Jail without further incident. A copy of this report will be faxed to DCF through the PSA section. Sgt. =Freeman was on scene. NFI
