AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF SEARCH WARRANT

BEFORE ME, Judge Lindsay Alvarez, in and for Hillsborough County,

Florida, personally appeared, **Amanda Baranowski**, who is employed as a sworn law enforcement officer with the **Tampa Police Department**, is a resident of the State of Florida, who being first duly sworn, deposes and says: Affiant has reason to believe and does believe that certain account information utilized in Hillsborough County, Florida as well as other jurisdictions, and stored by a provider of electronic or online social media communication service described as follows:

Being the account information stored by and under the care, custody or control of Snap Inc., 2772 Donald Douglas Loop North, Santa Monica, CA 90405, and there is now being kept on said premises or stored by a third party, certain data/information with evidentiary value to-wit:

9. All geolocation metadata.
10. All available content in the account to include pictures, videos, snaps, stories, memories, "my eyes only" memories, chats, chats media, and data that has been sent, received, and stored to the account.
11. Device(s) used.
12. IMEI data.
13. GUID number/data.

Which can provide evidentiary value in proving a violation of the laws of the State of Florida, to-wit: the laws prohibiting Lewd or Lascivious Battery (Engage), Lewd or Lascivious Molestation, Sexual Performance by a Child, Child Pornography, In State Transmission of Child Pornography by electronic Device, and Sexual Cyberharassment; Florida State Statute(s) 800.04(4)(a)1, 800.04(5)(a)(c)2, 827.071(3), and 827.071(5)(a), 847.0137(2), 784.049(3)(a), and subject to seizure pursuant to Florida State Statute 933.02.

The Affiant has personal knowledge of the matters set forth in this Affidavit and any attached Exhibits, and/or the information was imparted to me in the performance of my official duties as a law enforcement officer. Affiant has the required training and experience in these matters as follows:

Your Affiant, Amanda Baranowski, is employed by the City of Tampa Police Department, and as such is a law enforcement Officer with the State of Florida. Detective Amanda Baranowski has been employed by the City of Tampa Police Department since March 21st, 2011. Your Affiant has successfully completed a seven hundred seventy (770) hour Police Academy at Manatee Technical Institute operating under statutory authority and regulations of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (CJSTC). Your Affiant attended State College of Florida and Hillsborough Community College where she received her associate of arts degree. Your Affiant is currently assigned to the Tampa Police Department's Criminal Investigations Division, Special Victims Unit and is responsible for investigating sexual batteries, lewd offenses, child abuse/neglect and other various crimes against children and adults to include crimes of sexual cyberharassment and child pornography related offenses. Your Affiant is also responsible for emergency callouts assigned to her and following up as needed. Your Affiant has attended specialized training schools conducted by the Florida CJSTC. Your Affiant has in the past applied for and been granted search warrants within the jurisdiction of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, in and for Hillsborough County, Florida, which resulted in the seizure of evidence. Your Affiant has personal knowledge of the matters set forth in this affidavit and the information was imparted to your Affiant during the performance of her official duties as a law enforcement officer.

That the facts tending to establish the grounds for this application and the probable cause of Affiant believing that such facts exist are as follows:

On 10/19/2023, your affiant was assigned Tampa Police Department investigation 2023-530592 which involved sexual cyberharassment of child exploitation material. In that investigation, [REDACTED] stated that a female, known to them as "Alyssa Zinger" (defendant), sent the video to several [REDACTED] minor children through the social media platform Snapchat. The video was said to depict [REDACTED] engaging in sexual intercourse. [REDACTED] knew the defendant to be [REDACTED] [REDACTED] of their [REDACTED] peer, victim [REDACTED] Victim [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was also sent the

video by the defendant. They all believed the defendant to be near their age and homeschooled.

Your affiant spoke to victim [REDACTED] on 11/07/2023, who confirmed [REDACTED] engaged in a willful sexual act on or around the beginning of October, which [REDACTED] recorded with [REDACTED] cell phone. [REDACTED] further advised that [REDACTED] the defendant, who [REDACTED] knew as "Alyssa Zinger" recorded the video with her cell phone and sent it to several of [REDACTED] classmates through Snapchat. The Snapchat handle utilized to send the video was identified as "alyssazingerr".

Victim [REDACTED] stated that several days after recoding the video with [REDACTED] the defendant asked to come over to [REDACTED] residence to charge her cell phone. At one point while she was there, [REDACTED] left [REDACTED] cell phone unattended in her presence while [REDACTED] went to the bathroom. The defendant was able to gain access to [REDACTED] cell phone and recorded the videos and several pictures with her cell phone. Victim [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] came back from the bathroom to find the defendant recording the video with her phone.

Victim [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] engaged the defendant to obtain [REDACTED] cell phone from her and had to physically force her out of [REDACTED] residence to deescalate the situation. Furthermore, [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] contacted her father to advise him of what the defendant had done. Your affiant previously spoke with [REDACTED] who stated [REDACTED] received the video recording of [REDACTED] through Snapchat, which was sent to [REDACTED] by the defendant.

Your affiant spoke with victim [REDACTED] about how they met which [REDACTED] said was on Snapchat. [REDACTED] stated the defendant engaged [REDACTED] in a conversation on the social media platform, which was how they primarily communicated through their relationship. [REDACTED] stated they met at the end of May 2023 and [REDACTED] through the middle of September 2023. Victim [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] believed her to be approximately 14 years old and homeschooled. While speaking with [REDACTED] stated she physically seemed much older than her age.

Your affiant spoke with victim [REDACTED] about an incident [REDACTED] and the defendant were involved in on July 25th, 2023, where they were caught shoplifting from Nordstrom at the International Plaza (2023-353030). In this incident, the defendant identified herself as a juvenile using her name but providing a date of birth of 01/15/2009. The defendant identified her parents by name and corroborated several facts about her life. The officer did not locate any information for that name with that date of birth but did locate information for "Alyssa Ann Zinger with a date of birth of 01/15/2001. The defendant told the officer she had a half-sister with the same name. The defendant's contact with the officer was captured with his body camera.

Your affiant conducted research on the defendant and did not locate any information to corroborate her being a minor. Your affiant located information through the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) which corroborated her being an adult (22 years old). Your affiant requested school records under the defendant's name which came back indicating the defendant was an adult. Your affiant obtained employment records for the defendant, which again showed information supporting her being an adult and not a minor. The employment records showed the defendant worked for Publix Supermarkets, which was also later corroborated by victim [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] statement about their relationship.

After obtaining information concerning the defendant's actual age, a follow-up interview was completed with victim [REDACTED] on November 9th, 2023 concerning this investigation (2023-

901305). Victim [REDACTED] disclosed that [REDACTED] and the defendant had been physically intimate, which included willfully performing sexual acts on each other. Victim [REDACTED] corroborated this information by showing several photographs and videos of [REDACTED] and the defendant together and engaged in sexual activities.

Victim [REDACTED] confirmed the sexual relationship and activities began on or about May 27th, 2023, which is when they first met, and occurred through the duration of their [REDACTED] relationship which began on May 28th, 2023 and ended on or about mid-September 2023. Victim [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] and the defendant had engaged in sexual activity approximately 30 times over the course of their relationship at [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] disclosed the sexual activity included [REDACTED] to vagina intercourse and [REDACTED] to mouth oral sex performed on him by the defendant. Victim [REDACTED] stated that through their relationship, the defendant would send [REDACTED] sexually explicit photographs and videos of herself to [REDACTED] phone and through Snapchat from her phone and Snapchat account. Victim [REDACTED] further disclosed that the defendant admitted to [REDACTED] that she previously engaged in sexual activity with other [REDACTED] minors between the ages of [REDACTED] years old prior to and through the course of their [REDACTED] relationship.

Victim [REDACTED] disclosed that [REDACTED] and the victim continually communicated through Snapchat, with the last time her posting about [REDACTED] and reaching out to [REDACTED] being approximately two days prior to November 7th, 2023. I showed victim [REDACTED] the defendant's DHSMV photograph, which [REDACTED] identified as [REDACTED] with whom [REDACTED] previously engaged in sexual acts and communicated with on Snapchat.

On 11/13/2023, your affiant contacted the corporate office for Publix and confirmed the defendant was still an active employee with a hire date of 03/10/2023. I was advised the defendant was a part time bakery clerk.

On 11/15/2023, your affiant spoke with Publix Loss Prevention Associate T. Hester who advised the defendant worked for the Publix located at 10015 N Dale Mabry Hwy, Tampa, FL 33618.

Your affiant responded to the Publix located at 10015 N Dale Mabry Hwy, Tampa, FL 33618 and met with Assistant Manager M. Galindo and Bakery Manager Julie Whitley. I showed two photographs of the defendant to them, one provided by victim [REDACTED] and still photo captured from Officer Feinman's body camera footage, and they independently identified the defendant as the person in the photographs and stated she was an adult (over 18 years of age).

Based on the foregoing totality of circumstances, the Affiant has reason to believe and does believe that there are currently items of evidence related to an active criminal investigation, to wit: specific technical data/information pertaining to the use of Snapchat (Snap Inc.) account(s) with the below associated user/identifying information:

WHEREFORE, your Affiant hereby makes application for a Search Warrant authorizing the Affiant, police officers of the Tampa Police Department Hillsborough County, State of Florida, with proper and necessary assistance, including the assistance of digital forensic examiners from other agencies, to seize the described Snapchat (Snap Inc.) account(s) associated with username(s) and/or identifier(s) alyssazingerr; snap@alyssazingerr; 813-230-8381 in the daytime/nighttime, or on Sunday. The actual subscriber information seized will be listed on a return and inventory to be filed within this Judicial Circuit within ten days of execution of this warrant. However, the receipt of the physical data may take a significant time exceeding the ten days of execution of the warrant. For this reason, the "return" inventory will be satisfied by a list of the subscriber information being sought.



Snap Inc., 2772 Donald Douglas Loop North, Santa Monica, CA 90405 is also hereby **ORDERED** pursuant to F.S. 92.605(5), to provide, along with said materials, a certification or declaration from the custodian of records or another qualified person certifying or declaring that the records are authentic; Such record was made at or near the time of the occurrence of the matters set forth by, or from information transmitted by, a person with knowledge of those matters; Such record was kept in the course of a regularly conducted business activity; The business activity made such a record as a regular practice; And if such record is not the original, it is a duplicate of the original, unless the source of

information or the method or circumstances of preparation indicate lack of trustworthiness.

This search warrant or court order is issued under the "no-notice" provisions of law, per 18 U.S.C. 2703, 2705, F.S. 934.25 and other applicable provisions. Snap Inc., 2772 Donald Douglas Loop North, Santa Monica, CA 90405 is therefore hereby ORDERED that it shall NOT DISCLOSE to the customer(s) or subscriber(s) the existence of this warrant or the fact of a response because disclosing the existence of the warrant could potentially endanger the life or physical safety of an individual; could cause his/her flight from prosecution; could cause destruction of or tampering with evidence; could cause intimidation of potential witnesses; or could otherwise seriously jeopardize an investigation or unduly delay a trial.


