

**EMERGENCY MOTION AND REQUEST FOR HEARING TO REVOKE BOND**

COMES NOW the State of Georgia, by and through Assistant District Attorney Ansley House, and moves this Court to revoke bond in the above-styled case. In support of this motion, the State makes the following showing:

I.  
Defendant was arrested on November 13, 2022 for the offenses of Cruelty to Children in the First Degree, Cruelty to Children in the Second Degree, Simple Battery – Family Violence, and Public Drunkenness.

Defendant was granted a \$5,000 bond on November 15, 2022.

III.

Defendant's bond included the conditions that the Defendant shall reside with her mother, Donya Ridge, and shall remain law abiding. Defendant was required to not drink any alcohol while out on bond nor physically harm Alina Paschal and Elijah Paschal. Furthermore, Defendant was required to attend a parenting class program for 24 weeks and submit proof of
